"Bootlegger is a term for old guys back in the day who used to smuggle alcohol across state lines because they didn't want to pay taxes or stop drinking."

The 2 first Bootleggers editions gave us a precious experience and informations. No more «Gravel race» designation! Gravel is too restrictive and riders without any offroad background are surprised and not able to ride our event! The Malteni Bootleggers is a «UltraCX race», a cyclocross marathon where you will ride on asphalt, gravel, trails, technical singletracks, cobbles, sand, etc... You will have to push or carry your bike on the some terrils.

In 2019, we changed around 70% of the track.

Tour of Flanders climbs are replaced by around 20 playful terrils built by the last coal miners.

We're excited to challenge you on this surprising route!



CHALLENGE INFORMATIONS

We'll provide you a Check Points Card with your starting time wave Please be ready at least 5 minutes before the start of your wave!

The waves of 5 riders start every 60sec from 6:00am.

You must start from the starting line.

If you're late at your starting time, the chrono is already on...

We'll provide you the full route GPS file at least one week before the challenge. (.kml & .gpx)

Navigate with this route on this GPS. No signs on the route.

Follow the exact route, random controls scheduled.

Neon & reflective yellow jacket or armbands are mandatory for your security at the start.

NO HELMET, NO START!

Temperatures in april can be very variable: from -5°C to 30°C!

(2017: 0°C at the start / 25°C on the afternoon)

You'll be informed about the weather forecasts and conditions before the race.

We'll place 4 feed zones on the route but bring water and extra food with you.
You have to stamp your CP card at every feed zones.
Basic technical assistance at these zones.
NO ASSISTANCE ON THE PARCOURS by external support.

LITTERING = OUT OF THE RACE!
ROADS ARE OPENED TO TRAFFIC!
RESPECT THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS!

RIDE SAFELY, 5 seconds gained is nothing on such a ride...
RESPECT OTHER RIDERS (you'll ride from km160 with the last Paris Roubaix challenge riders)
RESPECT THE HIKERS AND HORSE RIDERS!

700c wheelset + drop bar (650b wheelset accepted) Maximum tyre size 42mm

WHAT WE ADVICE YOU...

CX, GRAVEL, ULTRACX frameset.

MUDDY CONDITIONS ADVICES: 38mm/42mm with mud thread (Compass Steilacoom) DRY CONDITIONS ADVICES: slick 38mm / 42mm (Compass Barlow Pass) Disc brakes with new pads recommanded. 2 Spare tubes, pump/co2 and tools. 2 bottles + energy food

A big autonomy GPS with the downloaded route. 2 GPS option. Front and rear LED lights are mandatory.













272 ICM 1000M TOTAL ELEVATION


